



Consultation on proposed Admission Arrangements for King's Academy Meadow Vale for September 2026

Introduction

King's Academy Meadow Vale is a recently converted academy school joining the King's Group Academies. King's Group Academies is now the admission authority for the school and are consulting on the admission arrangements for entry in the September 2026.

Consultations usually take place when admission authorities wish to make changes to their admission arrangements, or they have not been consulted on in the last 7 years. When converting to become an academy, King's Academy Meadow Vale automatically adopted the admission arrangements set by the Local Authority.

Although there are no changes proposed in this consultation, this is the first set of admission arrangements the school will determine as a new academy, and therefore are consulting to ensure the arrangements transferred into their own policy are clear and transparent to all that may use them.
